Our course will provide you with the practical and theoretical knowledge and skills needed to achieve the NEBDN dental nursing diploma qualification in order to qualify as a dental nurse professional and register with the General Dental Council. Although this course is recognised by both the General Dental Council in the UK and the Irish Dental Council in the Republic of Ireland, all trainees require their practical work to be signed off by a GDC REGISTRANT

The venue this year will be:

Your Course is a distance learning course with support mainly through phone, WhatsApp, Zoom and email although in some cases a face to face study day will take place prior to the examinations. Your final examination and OSCE will also be taken online which we will explain below.

Course info

The Course consists of 3 main parts: namely

1. Theory course - Online and Handbook with tutor support
2. Record of Experience - Completed Online with tutor support
3. Final Written exam and OSCE exam

1. Theory Course

12 monthly online modules that can be completed any time within the month (not on set dates), textbook and revision book supplied, 350 plus page bespoke handbook supplied, assigned tutor and 7 days a week support as well as community support from other members of your group and the course director.

2. Record Of Experience (ROE)

A Record Of Experience must be completed as a large part of this course in order for you to be entered for the examinations. This is a portfolio of evidence showing your competence to perform the required tasks of a dental nurse. (See WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE ROE info) The record of experience has to be completed but you do not get a grade as such for it, your pass/fail depends on the exam and OSCE at the end of the course.

ROE INFORMATION

A. 44 Practical Experience Records (PERS) - A Write up on a list of different practical experiences like assisting with a cavity preparation or disinfecting impression materials.

B. 22 supplementary outcomes (SO) - includes things like questions about setting up radiographic films or completing a lab prescription.

Early application is recommended as we are limited on places and so you can start the course on time, the lecture content of the course qualifies for verifiable CPD for which you will receive a separate certificate.

The course fee for 2024 enrolments is £1900 which includes one examination fee (Usually £510). Fees are payable in advance or we have a pay monthly option to spread the payments over 12 months. The monthly payment fee consists of a £510 deposit followed by 12 monthly payments of £125. Fees are non-refundable

You will be asked for payment by credit card/debit card or invoice depending on preference once we have received and confirmed your application. You can apply online at www.dentalnursecourses.co.uk

Please note once accepted on to the course, if you defer your entry to the following exam there will be a £100 deferral fee for NEBDN administrative costs associated with the exam and our ROC checking.

Resit fees are £200 for the written paper and £350 for the OSCE exam. You have 36 months from when you receive your ROE to complete the course in full.
